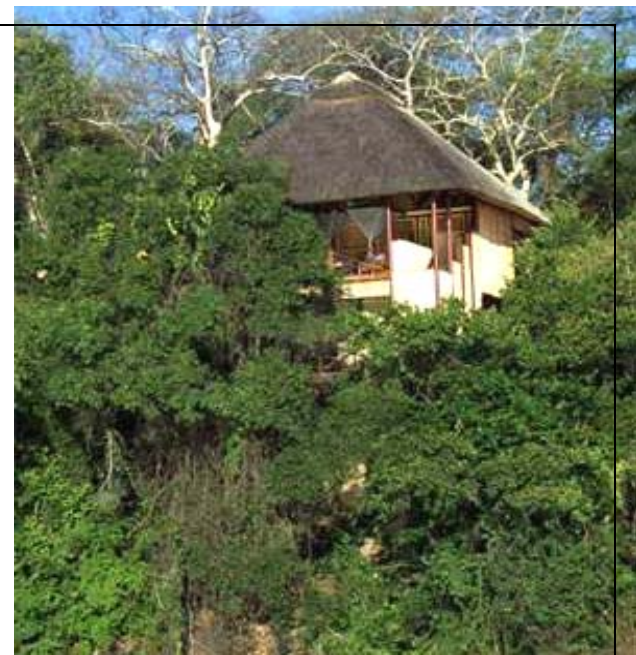




THE RIVER CLUB *of* Zambia



The River Club is situated on the Zambian side of the Zambezi River, eleven miles upstream from Victoria Falls. It faces westward into the sunset and onto the Zambezi National Park on the opposite side of the river. The River Club is set among the lush riverine vegetation and the camp has a distinct Edwardian flavor. Guests here can enjoy the sights and sounds of Victoria Falls and the Zambezi River in a peaceful and tranquil setting away from the crowds. Ten luxurious thatched chalets overlook the Zambezi River. The rooms are all completely open in the front giving guests the best possible views of the Zambezi. The main dining room, lounge, and pub area also has an interesting library.

Wildlife

- Rich birdlife, hippo and crocodile in the river, and impala, elephants, bushbuck etc along the river bank
- Near Livingstone there is a small national park (Mosi-oo-Tunya) with white rhino, giraffe, impala, waterbuck, zebra, wildebeest etc. (no cats)
