Samburu Intrepids Club is a luxury tented camp in the midst of the rugged and savagely beautiful semi-arid desert of northern Kenya. Located in the Samburu National Reserve on the banks of the Uaso Nyiro River, the club offers unique game viewing in its immediate surroundings. Twenty-seven tastefully furnished spacious tents are elevated on individual decks under the shade of huge acacia trees overlooking the river. Modern conveniences include hot and cold running water, flush toilets and electricity. The lodge is subtly constructed to enhance its closeness with nature. The occasional visits from the elephants and crocodiles below the decks will make your stay most memorable.
