Alaska

The Last Frontier: Glaciers & Whales

Starting at \$8,495 per person

10-days, begin Juneau/end Sitka. Aboard the 88-passenger motor yacht, Safari Endeavour, discover the wildlife, glaciers, and incredible scenery of Alaska. Ports of call include Tracy Arm, Stephens Passage, Thomas Bay, Baird Glacier, LeConte Glacier, Kake, Frederick Sound, Baranof Island, Peril Strait, Sergius Narrows, Neva Strait and Sitka.



Alaska, The Iditarod

The Greatest Endurance Race

Starting at \$2,995 per person

7-days, begin/end in Anchorage. Witness the ceremonial start of the Iditarod Race in Anchorage. Ride the Alyeska Resort Aerial Tramway to Mt. Alyeska and visit the Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center. Venture northward to Willow for the official start of the race, enjoying the beauty of the Knik River and the close by Knik Glacier. The Optional post extension is a visit to Rainy Pass Check Point to observe the mushers as they come and go.



Arizona

Desertscapes of the Grand Canyon State

Starting at \$4,995 per person

8-days, begin in Tucson/end in Scottsdale. This program is a mix of Mexican-American (Tlaquepaque village and El Charro Restaurant) and historic buildings/architecture of the old west and mining towns (Bisbee including a ride into the Queen Mine) and ranching (the OK Corral and Tombstone) mixed with art and natural history in Tucson and Sedona. Post extension to the Grand Canyon.



California

Nature's Playground: Forests, Canyons and Lakes

Starting at \$7,495 per person

11-days, begin/end in San Francisco. Hike in Sequoia and Kings Canyon National Parks, Yosemite, and visit Lake Tahoe & Muir Woods. A true wildlife haven with plenty of activities, vistas, and natural beauty. Post extension to Napa Valley.



California, San Diego

Beauty and Conservation in California's Fair Weathered South

Starting at \$3,995 per person

6-days, begin/end in San Diego. Visits include the San Diego Zoo, Torrey Pines State Park, Sea World, Balboa Park, Quail Botanical Gardens, Anza Borrego Desert State Park, and the California Wolf Center. Post Extension to Los Angeles.



California, San Francisco & Napa

Wine & Food in the Golden State

Starting at \$4,695 per person

7-days, begin/end in San Francisco. After sightseeing in San Francisco, take the Napa Valley Wine Train during dinner to arrive at the Napa Valley. Here, enjoy wine tastings and delicious cuisine, and visit St. Helena, Calistoga, Healdsburg, and the wonderful vineyards of this region.



Colorado & South Dakota

Western Splendor: From Mountains to Prairies

Starting at \$5,595 per person

8-days, begin in Denver/end in Rapid City. Explore Rocky Mountain National Park and Estes Park, Custer State Park, Mt. Rushmore, Badlands National Park, and the Northern Hills historic goldrush towns of Deadwood, Lead, and Spearfish. Post extension to Buffalo, Wyoming – TA Ranch.



District of Columbia, Washington

A Journey Through America's History

Starting at \$4,395 per person

5 days, begin/end in Washington DC. Visit many of the monuments and experience the local culture, politics and food. From the Supreme Court and White House, to Arlington National Cemetery, George Washington's home at Mt. Vernon, and Smithsonian Institute, and to the Civil Rights Trail, you will explore the history of this remarkable city.

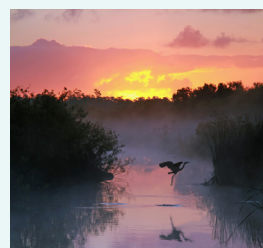


Florida

Swimming with the Manatees

Starting at \$2,895 per person

4-days, begin/end Tampa. The program includes a visit to the Manatee hospital at the Lowry Park Zoo, Florida Aquarium, dolphin cruise in Tampa Bay and swimming with manatees at King's Bay (headwater of the Crystal River). Post extension to the Everglades.



Florida

Beaches & Gators in the Sunshine State

Starting at \$5,595 per person

9-days, begin in Miami/end Ft. Myers. Start in Key West including stops at the Dolphin Research Center & the turtle hospital, cruise to Dry Tortugas, explore the Flamingo area, Shark Valley and Gator Park in the Everglades, and finish off exploring the mangroves and collecting seashells on Sanibel Island's pristine beaches.



Georgia & Alabama
Journey Through the History of the Civil Rights
Starting at \$5,795 per person

8-days, begin Atlanta/end Birmingham. Delve into the history of the civil rights, starting in Atlanta with visits to Martin Luther King, Jr. memorials and Ebenezer Baptist Church, and continue to Tuskegee National Historic Site. Onward to Montgomery and Selma, sites of civil rights marches, and end in Birmingham. This tour examines all aspects of the civil rights movement in the 60's and 70's and gives historic perspectives with visits to Museums and monuments. Post extension to Memphis, site of MLK's assassination.



Louisiana & Tennessee
The Musical Road from NOLA to Nashville
Starting at \$5,995 per person

10-days, begin in New Orleans/end in Nashville. From Bourbon Street in NOLA to Beale Street in Memphis, and Legends Corner in Nashville, this tour is an ode to the musical culture of these distinctive cities, homes to jazz, rock and roll, and country music. Also included is Vicksburg with its history from the Civil War, and swamp and plantation tours, exploring the best sites of each city, and feasting on delicious food. Post extension to Kentucky to explore the Bourbon Trail and racehorse farms.



Georgia
Southern Splendor & Natural Beauty
Starting at \$3,295 per person

6-days, begin/end Savannah. Explore Savannah and Georgia's Golden Isles: Jekyll, St. Simons & Cumberland Islands. Tour the sea turtle rescue center and the robber baron historic mansions at Jekyll Island, the colonial fort on St. Simons Island and see the feral horses at Cumberland Island National Seashore, the original horses brought to the island by the Spaniards in the 1500's.



Maine
Landscapes, Lighthouses & Lobsters in the Pine State
Starting at \$3,495 per person

6-days, begin/end Boston. Rocky coasts on churning seas, old fashioned lighthouses signaling to fishing boats on the shoals, and lobster dinners, fit for royalty awaits you. Kennebunkport, Ogunquit, lobster boat cruise, lighthouses, Bar Harbor & Acadia National Park are some of the highlights of this tour.



Hawaii
Seascapes in the Land of Aloha
Starting at \$7,295 per person

10-days, begin in Molokai/end in Kona. Aboard the 34-passenger motor yacht Safari Explorer, start in Molokai and discover the beauty of Hawaii with stops at Lana'i, Olowalu in west Maui, Honomalino Bay and Kona.



Massachusetts & Rhode Island
Enchanted Islands of New England
Starting at \$4,995 per person

8-days, begin/end in Boston. Start your touring at the Freedom Trail in Boston, explore historic homes of the Gilded Age in Newport, RI and also visit Block Island. Continue to Martha's Vineyard, Cape Cod, Hyannis, Chatham, enjoy a whale watching tour and finish with Nantucket. Post extension to Maine - Kennebunkport, lobster boat cruise, Bar Harbor & Acadia National Park.



Illinois, Chicago
Arts & Architecture in the 'Windy City'

5-days, begin/end in Chicago. Get behind the scene tours of Shedd Aquarium, The Art Institute, Millennium Park, taste some of the local delicacies, take a riverboat cruise to learn about its architecture, and explore the neighborhoods that make Chicago such a celebrated city.



Michigan
The Great Lakes: The Wolverine State and Beyond

11-days, begin/end in Detroit. Montana, Yellowstone National Park
Winter Wonderland
Starting at \$4,395 per person

8-days, begin/end in Bozeman. Yellowstone, America's first national park, is amazing no matter what time of year you visit, and during the cold season it is truly a winter wonderland. The program includes Mammoth Hot Springs, Lamar Valley, Old Faithful area, and Chico Hot Springs.



Louisiana, New Orleans
Food, Jazz & Nature in the 'Big Easy'

Montana, Yellowstone National Park
Beauty and the Beasts

6-days, begin/end in Bozeman. In the summer, Yellowstone transforms into a paradise for wildlife with incredible scenery, and geysers and fumaroles dotting the landscape. Visit Mammoth Hot Spring, Lamar Valley, and the Old Faithful area. Post extension to Grand Teton NP.

 12-days, begin in Missoula/end in Jackson Hole. Discover the amazing vistas of America's premier national parks, hike the beautiful trails, search for abundant wildlife, and enjoy the hospitality of the American West. Post extension to Goosewing Ranch near Jackson Hole.



New York, New York City

 5-days, begin/end in New York City. Nebraska, Grand Island
The Great Sandhill Cranes Migration

Starting at \$1,995 per person
 5-days, begin/end in Omaha. Visit the Henry Doorly Zoo in Omaha. Leave the bustle of Omaha behind that give way to open spaces as you make your way to central Nebraska and the Crane Trust. For 10,000 years, hundreds of thousands of Sandhill Cranes have been drawn to the Platte River in Nebraska during the month of March on their annual northward migration. Sweeping vistas await you in the historic prairie which is now home to the first herd of genetically pure bison in over 100 years.



New York, Hudson Valley
Valley Vistas and Local Legends

Starting at \$3,195 per person
 6-days, begin/end in New York City. Explore historic sites of The Legend of Sleepy Hollow, and an evening sail on the Hudson River. This program features the historic sites of Franklin Delano Roosevelt's and Rockefeller's homes and the iconic campus of West Point but also includes art, wine, and food.

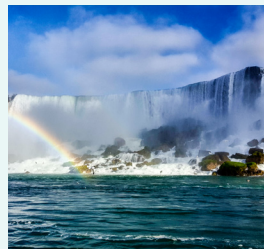
New York, Finger Lakes

 5-days, begin/end in Rochester, New York. This program highlights the fight for women's suffrage in the historic Finger Lakes region. Visits to Seneca Falls, the homes of Susan B. Anthony, Elizabeth Cady Stanton, Harriet Tubman, National Women's Hall of Fame, Hope Cemetery, and more, will highlight the struggle for women's suffrage, as well as the beauty of this region.



New Mexico & Colorado
Mountains, Deserts & Ranches of the Southwest

 10-days, begin in Albuquerque/end in Colorado Springs.
